



SPONSORED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Georgia Association of Convenience Stores Educational Foundation Scholarship Program offers company-funded or individually-funded Scholarship award(s). Sponsorship is designed so a company or individual person can offer scholarships awards, based on certain criteria, to a GACS member wholesaler, retailer or supplier employee or a dependent child of an employee. By sponsoring a member scholarship award, all applicants that apply for the sponsored award will automatically become eligible for all GACS funded scholarships for which they meet the criteria.

HOW DOES THIS SCHOLARSHIP WORK?

You determine which GACS member wholesaler, retailer or supplier you would like to sponsor and how much you would like to donate. You also pick the name of the award(s), the number of award(s), and the amount of the award(s). The scholarship criteria must include the general GACS selection criteria but you will be able to add in other stipulations that you choose.

To be eligible for a general GACS award you must:

- be a high school senior, college freshman, sophomore or junior.
- be a dependent child of an employee of GACS member company or be an employee of GACS member company with at least one year of continuous service as of January 1 of the year in which the scholarships are awarded.
- be or have a parent employed with a GACS member company at the time awards are announced.

When naming an award, some participants use their company's name, others choose to memorialize a company founder, and others name the award after a person who has made a large contribution to the endowment. Both the recipients and the colleges are informed of the name of the scholarship and the source of these funds.

WHAT WILL ALL THIS COST ME?

The minimum donation for a scholarship award is \$1,000. If you would like to contribute more than \$1,000, we suggest increasing the amount of the award or creating multiple scholarship awards. Administrative fees are paid by the educational foundation. The funds you provide to support your scholarships can be deducted as a charitable contribution, as the Foundation is a 501©(3) tax-exempt entity. The awards are paid to the college, and mailed to the student.

PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

To ensure complete impartiality in selection of recipients and to maintain a high level of professionalism, the program is administered by International Scholarship and Tuition Services, Inc., a firm that specializes in managing sponsored scholarship programs. GACS has no influence on choosing winners.
